State of Affairs



Failed Bail & Parole Reform

New York remains the only state that does not allow judges to consider a defendant's public safety risk when determining pre-trial release (NCSL). The U.S. Supreme Court has ruled that pretrial detention on public safety grounds is constitutionally permissible.



Addressing Raise the Age

The vast majority of 16- and 17-year-olds arrested for serious crimes are removed to Family Court and processed as Juvenile Delinquents or probation intake for "adjustment" services where they face little to no consequences.



Undermining Law Enforcement

The Democrat Majorities have put our law enforcement officers at risk by passing numerous laws that undermine the ability of law enforcement to do their jobs including the repealing of Section 50-a of the Civil Rights Law that protected personnel records from certain disclosure.
